SWISS DIVA angled in and dueled three deep, took a short lead into the turn, inched clear into the stretch and drew off under left handed urging. PRENUPTIAL chased outside then off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and held second. POKOMOKE unhurried outside then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for the place. DOUBLE MAJOR pulled her way along a bit off the rail to duel for the lead, angled in and fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. SWISS ROSE a bit slow to begin, chased inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ASIAN EYES stalked off the rail then between foes, angled in some on the turn and weakened. SEGO LILY sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between rivals on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. CHARM N BROAD squeezed a bit at the start, stalked between horses then inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
