Footnotes

WAY TOO MUCH chased inside, split horses leaving the backstretch, waited a bit along the rail on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up nearing the wire. RAINGEAR pulled between horses then stalked inside, bid between foes on the backstretch to gain the lead nearing the second turn, angled in and set the pace thereafter along the fence, inched clear in the stretch and held well but was caught late. MORGANOUSKA dueled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and held third. COLOURSOFTHEGLEN (IRE) chased between horses then inside, split rivals into the second turn, continued along the rail on that bend, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SKIMMING SKIPPER prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SKY'SQUICKSCORE four wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened. RHYTHM IN MAY saved ground off the pace, went around a rival early on the second turn, angled back to the fence and was not a threat. MY BOY LUKE settled three deep then outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and did not rally. ROMAN GUITAR sent between horses early, dueled inside, dropped back fast leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
