Footnotes

APPEALING TALE was bumped at the start, pulled and steadied on the inside entering the first turn, angled outside the pacesetter on the backstretch, bid for command at the quarter pole, led into the stretch and drew clear in the final furlong. COASTAL BREEZE was bumped at the start, saved ground around the first turn, moved closer on the second turn, rallied in the lane to be clearly second best but no threat to the winner. MENTOR CANE came through the open gate prior to the start, veered in at the break and bumped a rival, sped to the lead into the first turn, set the pace down the backstretch and around the second turn, was challenged for command at the quarter pole, could not go with the winner and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. DR. SPIN was unhurried down the backstretch and around the second turn, improved his position in the lane while passing tiring rivals. DEMOCRAT DUCK was between horses into the first turn, angled towards the rail,saved ground around the second turn and did not mount the necessary rally. BENEDICT AUDREY was three wide into the first turn, chased off the rail and weakened. RUSSDICULOUS was bumped between horses at the start, chased inside a rival around the first turn, saved some ground around the second turn and weakened in the lane. INFLAMED SPIRIT was hustled leaving the gate, stalked outside a rival around the first turn, stalked outside down the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way in the lane.
