**Footnotes**

TAKE CONTROL came off the rail on the first turn, went outside a rival on the backstretch, angled back in approaching the second turn, came out in upper stretch and again off heels past midstretch and rallied under left handed urging to surge to the lead and won clear. IVORY FUDGE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, inched away again nearing midstretch and held on well to deep stretch but could not contain the winner late. LINE OF DAVID pulled a bit between horses early, angled in and stalked inside, remained along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and just held third. BRACE YOURSELVES three deep early, stalked the pace off the rail then outside a rival, bid between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for the show. EL GRAN MATADOR stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAYBE YES a bit slow to begin, settled outside then stalked alongside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. VIVA MACHO pulled his way along off the rail then between horses, continued off the inside leaving the backstretch, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
