MALIBU CANYON stalked between horses then inside on the turn, came out in midstretch and rallied between rivals under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. CRASH LANDING went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back inside foes in deep stretch and continued willingly to hold second. BRIAN THE BRAVE chased outside or off the rail, went three deep on the turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted in some and also went on willingly three deep between foes late. SPINNING SOUND (IRE) wide early, angled in and settled outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and put in a late bid outside foes. BLACK KETTLE was in a good position chasing the pace inside, came out into the stretch, was between foes nearing midstretch and was outfinished. PHANTOM STRIKE settled outside a rival then inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and bested the rest. LITTLE BRO chased between horses then outside a

rival, angled in off heels leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed response. AMAZING FEAT had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, stalked on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. OSCAR THE MAYOR had speed four wide then stalked outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened. MAT THE MAITER'D was unhurried between horses early then settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a factor. WARREN'S OPERATOR dueled between horses then three deep, stalked off the rail leaving the backstretch, was between rivals again on the turn and three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive. BIG WATER wide early, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was outrun.
