Footnotes

CAYAMBE content to lag back from off the rail, came in some later on the backstretch, angled back out bit on the turn, came three wide into the lane, angled out further in the drive, roused then surged under strong handling and nailed leader in final strides. AMAZOMBIE moved up inside then came out and pressured the pacesetter, challenged outside that rival on the turn, gained lead then shook free into the lane but could not stave off the winner. EARNEDNEVERGIVEN was off alertly and stepped to the front, angled in and set the fractions from the inside, resisted briefly on the turn, lost command but gamely held the show. THE BAT SIGNAL stalked from along the rail to the turn, came out some around the turn and into the stretch and lacked needed late punch. MY SUMMER SLEW tracked the pace while outside foe or off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, was inside the winner passing the eighth marker but lacked any late response. DANCING IN SILKS was off bit slow, outside foe chasing the leaders, remained off the rail then four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten.
