**Footnotes**

FREESPOOL sped to a short early lead and dueled between horses, inched away on the backstretch, set the pace a bit off the rail and proved best under steady handling. MEN'S EXCLUSIVE saved ground chasing the early leaders, went up between horses on the turn and into the stretch, could not catch the winner but bested the others. LEXICON pressed or stalked the pace three deep to the stretch, then had no late bid but held third. CAPO DI CAPO off a bit slowly, was outrun a bit off the rail early, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary rally. RAPIDOUGH had a rail trip forcing or stalking the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. LESTERS BOY prompted the early pace four wide then tracked the winner leaving the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the turn and weakened. SON OF A PISTOL bobbled sharply at the start to drop back, angled in leaving the backstretch, rode the rail on the turn and was outrun.
