Footnotes

KING'S DRAMA (IRE) prompted the early pace then stalked off the rail, bid again alongside the runner-up past midstretch and gamely wore down that one under some urging. RAILROAD took the early lead and set the pace inside, fought back gamely along the rail through the drive and continued willingly to the wire. HENDRIX saved ground stalking the pace, was boxed in along the rail from midstretch to the sixteenth pole, came out late and bested the others. PORFIDO (CHI) stalked the pace off the rail, fell back some between foes on the second turn, had the rider lose the whip past midstretch and lacked the needed response. DON INCAUTO (ARG) chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SOUTHERN AFRICA allowed to settle outside a rival to the stretch, did not rally. CAPITANO saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and was not a threat. RHYTHM MAD (FR) broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch and second turn and failed to menace.
