JUDGE GALLIVAN sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the fence through the final furlong and held on gamely under urging. GHOST ACTOR chased outside, went up three deep into and on the second turn, bid alongside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but could not get by. IRON DUKE chased inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, responded to urging before the rider lost the whip late to just edge a rival for third. GET OFF THE SUGAR pulled his way along off the rail or outside, came three deep into the stretch and just lost the show. THE RYE MAN unhurried off the rail to the second turn, came out on the bend and five wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. IMITATION chased between horses or a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. WAR SCANDAL stalked off the rail then between foes into the second turn, continued off the inside leaving that turn and weakened. BELTLINE JACK saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back leaving the second turn and also weakened.
