**Footnotes**

LATIN LOBO dueled between horses, fought back in the stretch, gained the lead in deep stretch, inched away under some urging and held. THE ROYALS COURT settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and again at the wire for the place. GOLDEN GORILLA stalked outside, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and just got the show. SKIMMING ON ICE had speed between horses then stalked of the rail, came out into the stretch, continued between foes in the drive and was edged for a minor award. MR. EXCESSIVE dueled between rivals then three deep on the backstretch and turn, regained a short advantage three wide in the stretch and was edged late for a minor award. ZOOMIN ZABEL chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. DISTINCTIVE AFLEET broke a bit slowly, went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened late. AMERICAN DRAGON had speed five wide then stalked outside, continued between horse on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. MR BIG TOPPER broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, dropped back into and on the turn and was done early.
