Footnotes

SEA RASCAL prompted the pace between horses, bid again alongside the runner-up past midstretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under a left handed tap of the whip and good handling. ITALIAN RULES sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, inched away in the stretch, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly but was edged late. NIKKI'SGOLDENSTEED saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, went around a rival in midstretch and continued willingly to best the others. MR. MONKEY JONES angled in and saved ground stalking the pace throughout and lacked the needed late kick. B R REMARK chased three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, continued outside, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. POSITION A stalked between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. USURP prompted the pace outside the top pair, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
