Footnotes

UNUSUAL HEATWAVE stalked outside then off the rail, drifted four wide crossing the dirt but rallied under urging to gain the lead four wide in deep stretch to prove best. CHICKIE CHARMS had good early speed off the rail, dueled outside a rival then stalked leaving the hill, drifted out some into the stretch, came back on between horses in deep stretch and edged a foe for the place. THE ROAN RANGER saved ground off the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and rallied along the rail. SPIT BALL settled off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and finished with interest outside. CAT'S ENOUGH went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away leaving the hill, kicked clear off the inside in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. LATE NIGHT SKY pulled between horses chasing the pace, stalked outside a rival leaving the hill, came out then was fanned out five wide crossing the dirt and lacked the needed rally. HIGH DUTY broke inward and a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, angled in leaving the hill and improved position in the stretch. GURNICK pulled early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside to the stretch and weakened. TIME TO DOUBLEDOWN chased three deep then off the rail

leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MANK broke slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. TORUK MAKTO angled in and saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. JAKOB'S MAGIC unhurried outside a rival then off the rail leaving the hill, failed to menace. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
