Footnotes

ONE GOOD SHARK was on the early pace then was outkicked leaving the half mile pole, rallied four wide on the turn then swung widest into the stretch, responded to strong handling and raced clear in the final sixteenth. BENNY'S BENCHMARK was outsprinted early but hustled up widest nearing the turn, dueled four wide to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then was no match for the winner while besting the rest. UNCOMMON SENSE was on the pace in the early stages, got outrun from the half mile pole to the turn, raced three then four wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed late response. INBETWEENTHESHEETS stalked the pace early, rallied inside the runnerup and three wide on the turn, dueled to mid stretch but tired through the final furlong. KID ATLANTIC was hustled early, dueled to the turn then got outkicked to the stretch and gave way. MY MANS NO LADY had speed to the turn, tired after a half and gave out through the stretch.
