### Footnotes

CAVANAL never far back to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, got to terms to mid stretch then dug in gamely through the final furlong and got the best of COLORFUL DANCER late. COLORFUL DANCER pressed the action for a half mile, bid three wide to engage MAJESTIC AMERICAN for the lead on the second turn, responded when hooked by the winner in mid stretch but was bested in the final yards. GAMBLING MAN was allowed to settle to the half, offered a bid from the two path on the second turn, was blocked behind horses from the quarter pole until upper stretch, angled out for room but lacked the needed response once clear. MAJESTIC AMERICAN set the pace for five furlongs, responded to urging to the stretch but was tiring in the final furlong. SIR BEN had no speed, raced three wide on the second turn then closed a minor gap without being a serious threat. GREY ALYCATTa had no speed and was outrun.
