Footnotes

TRAINSPOTTING raced close up in the early stages but slipped back into the turn, advanced from the extreme outside to the stretch, continued to respond in the lane and was up late to win going away. SIDEPOCKET LOU dueled from the inside and gave way grudgingly. ANDREW'S TURN settled early, raced in the three path on the turn and came on too late. THERE GOES KEVIN settled early, offered a menacing bid four wide into the lane and flattened out. DR. J J was never too far back, had a nice bid outside at the quarter pole but could not sustain it in the drive. ETERNALLY FAST battled from between horses into the stretch and slackened. CUSTOM CONTINENTAL attended the pace three wide to mid turn and weakened. NATIONWIDE FAMILY raced unhurried early, was fanned five wide on the turn and closed a gap. HUMOROUS GUY was never a factor.
