Footnotes

GOOD MANGO tracked the pace to the backstretch, moved up to take command after a half mile and set all of the pace from off the rail, met a bid from ELAINE'S TENACITY while being bumped by that rival near the furlong pole, then got to drifting out late and again bumped with that rival and just held. ELAINE'S TENACITY raced unhurried early from off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in sharply near the furlong pole while rallying, bumped with the winner then was bumped again late but could not get by. SISTERMARYELEPHANT was forwardly placed from the rail and unhurried, came five wide on the second turn but had no rally. KAWANI RUN was well placed just off the leaders, raced three wide on both turns and did not rally. MISS LAKE showed little. CELAYA'S PRIZE took command early to set the pace from off the rail but had little left once headed. KATHYS MAJECTIC was always outrun. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the stretch run of the first two horses but found nothing to warrant altering the original finish.
