GATA DE ORO broke alertly and dueled two wide to the stretch, forged to the front and held driving. ALL SIX SISTERS stalked the dueling leaders from the outset, came three wide to the stretch and closed a mild gap late. TIZ CROWDED was permitted to settle early, raced in the two path on the turn, came out for the drive and finished willingly. VICTORIOUSLY JEWEL settled early, raced four wide on the turn and finished in a mild rally. LEWKODONIA dueled inside the winner to the stretch and faded. LEFT BAY steadied at the start and was never a factor. CREME RINSE was always outrun.
