Footnotes

MUTE RUDULPH showed good speed, dueled for the lead to the turn, was fanned out four wide into the stretch, responded while racing greenly in the drive and held off PIPER'S FRIEND late. The latter pressed the pace in the early stages, took back in traffic into the turn, angled out and came five wide into the stretch then was gaining in the late stages. COLE IS THE MAN dueled inside the winner to the turn, drifted three wide into the stretch, battled to mid stretch but was tiring late. BABY FACE ASSASSIN took back while a bit rank in the early stages, trailed to the turn, was four wide to the stretch and failed to offer the needed response. TEMPESTA GATO was an early pace factor, raced three wide while being outsprinted on the turn and also lacked a late bid. MR. ELK GROVE had no speed and was outrun. CHATTY LOU was used in the early stages but outsprinted, raced three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive.
