Footnotes

PISTOU broke on top and dueled outside WHATA DREAM to the turn, disposed of that rival but kept something in reserve to repel late bids and held driving. SMART BLUES stalked the pace from the outset, entered the turn four wide, moved up to offer his bid from the three path into the lane and was edging closer at the wire. SOUND OF MONEY was never too far back, came four wide to the stretch, loomed a bold factor inside the sixteenth pole but hung late. COULD BE DREAM'N raced close up from the rail early, was shuffled back nearing the three eighths but kept to her task and was actually coming back on. LIVING THE MOMENT settled early, raced three wide on the turn but failed to reach serious contention. ALOHA D J lacked early speed, raced off the rail on the turn and closed a gap late. WHATA DREAM pressed the winner from off the rail early then dropped inside for the turn and weakened. OH ME OH MY veered out badly at the start to be off slow, came three wide on the turn and was never a factor. CONCRETE RIPPLES had no speed.
