Footnotes

TAKING A SHOT took back early and lagged to the second turn, circled rivals four wide into the lane, rallied steadily and was up late to win going away driving. LATIN SCHOLAR was well positioned early from off the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch to gain command late but could not hold off the winner. STORMIN AHEAD attended the pace from outside from the rail, led into the stretch but slackened in the lane. AWESOME PRINCE settled early, moved up steadily from the outside on the backstretch to be challenging for the lead four wide on the second turn but lost his punch in the lane. ENTERPRISE ZONE dueled from off the rail and weakened. FULLY LOADED CLIP showed some early speed but was finished after a half mile. CURLY BOY stalked the pace two and three wide then came up empty. MR. ELK GROVE was never a factor.
