WAY TOO MUCH raced up three wide on the first turn to track the pace, offered his bid four wide into the lane, made the lead at the furlong pole, drifted inward slightly late and held driving. FU PEG HE RAT settled early from the rail but was always within striking distance, eased out to challenge three wide into the stretch, was brushed late by MICHAEL THE MAN and was forced out then steadied late inside the winner. MICHAEL THE MAN stalked the pace four wide to the backstretch, slipped back slightly to the half but offered a menacing bid outside STRIKINGLY SINFUL to gain command near the quarter pole, drifted out through the lane and brushed with FU PEG HE RAT and slackened. BRICKYARDTRADITION raced unhurried early from off the rail, was in the three path into the stretch and lacked a rally. AMBEKAY prompted the pace early two wide but began to fade after a half mile. STRIKINGLY SINFUL set the pace from the inside to the quarter pole and gave out. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the stretch run of the top three but allowed the original finish to stand.
