**Footnotes**

SING FOR GOLD broke with the leaders but was permitted to slip back from the inside in the opening quarter, commenced her bid nearing the stretch, eased to the extreme outside and closed steadily to get up late and win driving. DEMOCRATIC SWEEP was never far back from the outside, was forced four wide into the stretch, had her bid leaving the furlong pole, but was outfinished by the winner. POWERS LILSIS stalked the pace between horses, was three wide on the turn but lacked the needed rally. GREAT AUNT NORA raced close up early, had her best bid from the rail nearing the furlong pole and flattened out. GONGING WILD sprinted clear early to set the pace from off the rail but had little left once in the stretch.
