SEE ZO GO broke alertly then was outsprinted to the first turn, stalked four wide to the far turn, rallied four wide to the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch and held driving. TWAIN'S TITAN had no speed, was four wide to the stretch then made up ground belatedly to get the place. SKYRIBBON was also outsprinted, checked leaving the first turn, settled to the half mile pole, bid three wide to the stretch then was outfinished in the late stages and nipped for second. BI TOMORROW attended the pace while racing off the rail to the second turn, remained two wide to the stretch but weakened through the drive. MAGICO had good speed, dueled outside of BI TOMORROW and three wide to the stretch then also tired. SIBERIAN RUSH had no speed and saved ground on the second turn to no avail.
