Footnotes

SUPERCABRAS broke a step slow but was quickly in contention and raced unhurried to the turn, circled rivals four wide into the stretch, responded to rally steadily and was up in the final stride. NORTHERN POPTART stalked the pace four wide early, moved up three wide on the turn to be challenging for command once in the stretch, led late but could not hold the winner. TWO STEP SATURDAY dueled from between horses into the stretch and gradually faded. NOBYJO lacked the speed of the leaders and got shuffled back from just off the rail into the turn, then saved ground but did not rally. JEWELS OF FIRE lagged early, came three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. LEAVE IT TO CHANCE dueled four then three wide into the stretch but stopped leaving the furlong pole. JUGADOR was also shuffled back from the rail into the turn but continued to fade. SMOKIN MOJO dueled from the inside and came up empty.
