MARKS MINE broke in stride but was not asked to go with the pacesetter, rallied two wide into the stretch to gain command once straightened for the drive, took a clear lead at the furlong pole and extended the advantage driving. PARIS IN APRIL raced unhurried early, saved ground on the turn, angled out once in the stretch and finished steadily. ENGLISH ROYAL settled early within striking distance, offered a menacing bid three wide into the lane but flattened out. QUIZZICAL lagged early, raced two wide on the turn and came on without being a serious factor. FIGHTIN MEAN MAD was quickly in front and while crossing over bumped solidly with DISTINCTIVE YOLIE in the opening sixteenth, sprinted clear then had little left for the drive. DISTINCTIVE YOLIE was bumped solidly by FIGHTIN MEAN MAD early on and steadied, recovered to track that rival into the stretch but lacked a closing response. GOING FOR A SPIN was void of any early speed, raced well off the rail on the turn and failed to offer a bid. PRIMA GIANNA flashed brief speed only. following a stewards inquiry, FIGHTIN MEAN MAD was disqualified and placed sixth for interference to DISTINCTIVE YOLIE in the early stages.
