PLEASANT PROSPECT rushed up between rivals early in the backstretch to duel with the front end, responded when asked on the final turn, was joined by EAST FROM WEST a furlong from home, turned back that one and pulled clear late. EAST FROM WEST raced unhurriedly to the final turn, bid five wide, loomed boldly turning for home, garnered a brief lead at the furlong pole and flattened in the final yards. BARACHO raced wide throughout, found his best stride on the backstretch, rallied outside and then flattened when more effort was needed. ONERY DOLLARS sped to the lead before the first turn, set a pressured pace to the quarter pole while racing on the inside and weakened in the stretch. MORTON OWEN raced mid pack to the second turn, came four wide and rallied mildly without menacing the front ones. SMOKIN DIXI chased the leaders from the start could not reach contention and came home evenly. SNUFFY SMITH showed little. IRISH ROVER broke the quickest and gradually dropped back.
