Footnotes

ELUSIVE MOMENT contested the pace between rivals to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then edged away under steady urging. SLAM SLEW stalked the pace to the turn, came three wide to the stretch then finished steadily but could not impact the winner. A PINT FOR MARY tracked the leaders to the turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MAJESTIC VINTAGE had good speed and was clear in the opening furlong, dueled from the rail to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch by the winner and weakened in the latter stages. DR. J J also tracked the pace to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but failed to rally in the drive. MALIBU CANYON had early speed, dueled outside horses to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then gave way through the final eighth. MUTE RUDOLPH chased the pace to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch but had little to offer in the drive. STATELY TOM was always outrun. MOVE OVER MARINO was slow to settle, saved ground on the turn then swung out severely into the stretch and tired.
