Footnotes

TWAIN'S TITAN broke in stride and dueled from between horses throughout, responded gamely in the stretch and outdueled BETTINGONTHETRUTH in the late stages. BETTINGONTHETRUTH was permitted to settle early while three wide to the backstretch, moved up from the four path on the second turn to gain command in the stretch but could not quite hold off the winner in the final stages. AMORE DI ALEYNA raced unhurried from the rail early, advanced two wide early on the second turn, challenged from the rail into the stretch but slackened in the drive. MAHMOUD MEMORY dueled early from the inside but was finished after five furlongs. SIERRA SEVEN raced up four wide into the first turn to alternate on the lead for a half mile but gave way suddenly. MARINE FOG settled early from off the rail, offered a brief bid from the inside into the second turn but could not sustain that speed.
