PROFOUND ELEGANCE tracked the pace from the extreme outside early, moved up five wide early on the turn, challenged four wide into the stretch, drew clear and extended her advantage while being kept to her task. TOO PINK lagged early, raced in the three path on the turn and came on for the place without bothering the winner. CRUZ'N KITTY was never too far back, moved up three wide and between horses to gain a short lead on the turn but had little left for the drive. CASHMERE MIST was not asked for speed early, angled five wide on the turn and failed to rally. SHEZAMUSING stalked the pace early, was four wide and behind a wall of horses on the turn but had no response in the stretch. CONDITIONER raced a bit rank inside SAMPAQUITA to the turn and gave way suddenly. SAMPAQUITA set all of the pace from off the rail to mid turn and stopped badly.
