Footnotes

BEAMER BEE prompted the pace to the turn, rallied two wide and collared TRIBAL LADY into the stretch, inched clear to mid stretch then held under steady urging. AVADA KEDAVA tracked the pace from the rail to the quarter pole, shifted out for room into the stretch, rallied steadily late but could not catch the winner. TRIBAL LADY had good speed, set a pressured pace to the quarter pole, was collared by the winner into the stretch and weakened late. OUTSIDE DINING stalked the pace to the turn, offered a bid three wide to the stretch then finished steadily without making an impact. HOUSE OF CRYSTAL was outrun to the turn, also raced three deep to the stretch then finished evenly late. EVELYN'S GIRL broke inward, was outsprinted to the turn, chased between rivals to the stretch but failed to offer a late response. STAR PASSERS BEST broke a bit slow and avoided EVELYN'S GIRL at the start then was not a factor.
