RIKA JIKA JACK sped immediately to the front, was joined by TIPPETARIUS before the half mile pole, dueled with that one to the quarter pole and gradually edged clear. TIPPETARIUS rushed up to duel with the winner to the quarter pole, could not match strides with him but gamely held the place. SMOOTH DOLLARS never far back, bid three wide, had little response when asked for more turning for home but found a little more in the late going. SNUFFY SMITH tracked early, inched up through the turn, loomed boldly but flattened in the drive. DUSTIN THE TRACK chased the pace to the stretch, turned for home on the outside and could not rally. MOSCATO raced on the inside to late in the turn, flared out six wide turning for home and showed some late interest without menacing the top ones. QUARTERBACK CRUNCH after an awkward start did not reach contention. EL MOLO was slow into stride and always outrun.
