### Footnotes

LAKESHORE COURT was hustled from the gate to take a clear lead, drew off in the upper stretch and held driving. EL GRAN BULL was forwardly placed from the outset, raced two wide on the turn but could not threaten the winner, then had to be vanned off due to heat stroke. SKIING CHUMAREE settled early, raced four wide on the turn but did not respond. THROW IT TREY lacked good early speed, advanced three wide on the turn but flattened out in the lane. CAT MAN JOE was slow early, raced two wide on the turn and failed to rally. SUPPLY N DEMAND was never a factor. MY BRAVEHEART had no early speed and failed to respond while four wide on the turn. WARREN'S ANDREW chased the winner to the stretch and stopped. PHANTOM AFFAIR had no speed. MATH WIZ broke slow, and was through early then was eased but walked off.
