Footnotes

CLASSIELYTE broke alertly then took back off the leaders, moved up three wide on the turn, collared DRIVING CAT in mid stretch and edged clear driving. DRIVING CAT pressed the pace two wide from the outset, took a narrow lead at the quarter pole, maintained a slim lead to mid stretch then could not match strides. YORKVILLE KID took back at the start and raced unhurried to the turn, came four wide to the stretch and finished willingly. WHOLETOWNUNDRWATER was not asked for speed early, raced off the rail on the turn, angled widest for the drive and closed a gap. UNIQUE EFFORT stalked the pace from the inside, was boxed on the turn but had no response once clear in the stretch. ANDREW'S TURN settled early, was between horses on the turn but failed to rally. EVEN ODDS lacked the early speed of the leaders then came up empty while two wide into the lane. PATRIATE set the pace from the inside to the quarter pole and gave out. CHIEF OF POLICE had no speed.
