**Footnotes**

DEPUTY PRIZE showed good speed and set all the pace, turned back DOUBLE EPISODE into the stretch, edged away to mid stretch then was under steady handling late. POSITIVE TREND was allowed to settle, saved ground on the second turn, angled out for room in upper stretch and was closing ground steadily late. DOUBLE EPISODE prompted the pace for a half mile, advanced three wide to get to terms with the winner on the second then was outkicked to mid stretch and weakened. CANDY'S PRIDE tracked the pace to the second turn, was caught out four deep to the stretch and failed to rally. SO GONE was outsprinted early, also tracked the pace to the half, bid two wide on the second turn to briefly loom a threat but tired in then stretch. TURKISH BEAUTY was three wide throughout and did not rally. CARIBBEAN MAGIC was caught out four wide on the first turn, settled to the half, remained four deep to the stretch and also failed to respond in the drive. KICKIN CAPER pressed the pace to the second turn, offered a brief bid three wide then stopped suddenly in mid stretch, was eased but walked off.
