PISTOIA broke alertly and dueled in the early stages then quickened when asked and drew clear on the turn, remained well clear to mid stretch then was under steady urging to hold. PLAZA QUEEN chased the winner to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then was gaining late. COUNTY WEXFORD was a pace factor to the turn then was outkicked by the winner, raced three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BRAVE BESS broke in a tangle then lugged out down the backstretch, was straightened before reaching the turn, came three wide to the stretch, eased widest in upper stretch and made a belated run. HAAS'N ALIBI had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch then closed a gap without being a real threat. CIACCI'S ANGEL also had no speed, raced three then four wide to the stretch and could not make an impact. TIZ BIZZY was outsprinted early, chased to the turn, was three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. MARY THE PRINCESS tracked the early pace, was also outkicked on the turn and gave way in the lane.
