POWERS LILSIS edged up inside to dueled with SQUARE GENIUS through the turn, pulled clear turning for home and was not threatened in the drive. NEWPORT LULU never far back, bid four wide, loomed boldly straightening in the stretch, could not match strides with the winner but was clearly second best. DOALITTLERAINDANCE slow to find his stride, lagged to the turn, edged up between rivals, swung out four wide and closed willingly but was no match for the top two. TERINA broke alertly, immediately dropped back and had little response when needed. SQUARE GENIUS away quickest, broke out of the pack early, set the pace to the stretch and came up empty. JAZZIN THE STORM showed brief early speed and gradually dropped back. HASTY PROMISES was never in contention.
