Footnotes

JUSTIFIABLE was hustled and outsprinted SIERRA SILVER CAT for the lead, set the pace while off the rail to the stretch then responded to strong urging and held late. SIERRA SILVER CAT was used early but was outsprinted by the winner, pressed from the rail to the stretch then shifted out for the drive but could not make an impact late while second best. TIP TOE TOPPER was a bit awkward at the start but recovered quickly, chased the pace early then was crowded inside of MEAN JOLEEN and forced to take up nearing the seven sixteenths, shifted out and commenced a bid while circling four wide to the stretch then finished willingly in a good effort. SEA YA WAGER stalked the pace to the turn, was three wide and remained a factor to mid stretch then could not muster the needed late response. MEAN JOLEENE tracked the leaders early, crowded TIP TOE TOPPER leaving the half mile pole, saved ground to the stretch, was a threat to mid stretch but came up empty late. MEGAHOTTIE broke slow, had no speed, was three wide to the stretch and gave way. WINDY SEA chased the pace between rivals to the quarter pole then gave out. FOR THE LADY broke a bit slow and was not a factor.
