FLYING GWEN showed the best speed, set a pressured pace while just off the rail to the stretch then edged clear to mid stretch and held on late. WHISPERING DIXIE was crowded by FLIRT WITH JUSTICE and checked back at the start, advanced three wide on the turn then shifted inside in mid stretch and surged in the late stages. RUCKUSING STORM had no speed, was two wide while advancing on the turn then eased out for room and was closing ground belatedly. TANGO ONE also had no speed, entered the turn four wide then was forced to circle six wide to the stretch but closed ground willingly late. GOOD TIMES TWEENUS prompted the pace outside the winner to the stretch, remained a factor to mid stretch but tired in the final sixteenth. HAMMETT STAR chased the pace to the turn, made her best bid inside to the quarter pole then weakened through the drive. FLIRT WITH JUSTICE broke a bit awkwardly and crowded the runnerup then chased the pace, got fanned five wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. FANCY SUMMER stalked the pace to the turn, was caught four wide to the stretch and gave way through the final furlong.
