COOL YOUR JETS had no speed, bid three wide to mid turn then swung out six wide into the stretch, rallied when set down and surged in the late stages to be along in time. RIVER FOX was allowed to settle to the turn, rallied two wide then angled out into the stretch, dug in determinedly and briefly held the advantage in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. HOLD THE PEACE had no speed, was inside of the turn and angled five wide into the stretch then closed willingly but was too late. IS IT TUESDAY YET attended the pace outside rivals to the turn, was three wide to the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch, continued to lead to deep stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. STARS IN HEAVEN chased the pace to the turn, came four wide to the stretch, rallied into contention to mid stretch then lost his punch in the final furlong. BASS RIVER contested the pace to the turn, saved ground and was still a factor to mid stretch but gave way in the final eighth. WHITE MARK was not a factor. VALID COPY set a pressured pace to the stretch then stopped.
