JIMTOWN was taken in hand after the start and rated through the first circuit, steadily advanced to the second-last jump, rallied on the last turn to challenge for the lead at the last jump, dueled throughout the stretch and was up in the final two strides under right-hand urging. SERGEANT KARAKORUM stalked the early pace into the backstretch the second time, steadily advanced to challenge on the last turn, dueled with the winner throughout the stretch and just missed under rigorous right-hand urging. SOUTHWEST prompted the early pace, dropped back on the first turn to stalk the top two leaders, rallied to challenge for the lead on the second-last jump, dueled into the upper stretch and tired. HI FLYIN INDY was always outrun and passed tired rivals. PERFECT EDGE pressed the pace through the first circuit, dueled for the lead on the backstretch the second time, led for a short lead near the final turn and then tired. EASY REACH set the pace to the third turn, dueled to the third-last jump, tired, and was pulled up before the last jump. WORLD OF EVENTS raced in the middle of the pack through the first circuit, tired and was pulled up at the second-last jump. MAN TO MAN had only brief speed, trailed and was pulled up at the second-last jump.
