Footnotes

STOPCHARGINGMARIA away alertly from the starting gate, took control, tucked along the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, was unasked for run showing the way, with the runner up being the primary pursuer, parked to the outside, had already drifted into the two path when set down for the drive home, held a fairly straight course thereafter, crossing the wire under a vigorous hand ride. J. QUIRK took up the role of primary pursuer in the opening stages, was under some coaxing giving chase on the winner two wide on the bend, spun into the stretch and drafted behind the top one for several jumps, needed some effort by the pilot before cooperating enough to alter course in the direction of the middle of the strip in the vicinity of three-sixteenths marker, steadily lost contact with STOPCHARGINGMARIA yet remained well ahead of the others for the place. PREDICATE along the rail, appeared uncomfortable travelling between and amongst foes while proceeding down the backstretch, went about more professionally while tracking the front runners from the rail on the turn, vacated the premises and after having been given her cue angled three wide into the stretch, proved no match. ART OF THE GAME broke two to three lengths behind the penultimate breaker after lunging inward and making solid contact with the left side of the starting gate, rejoined the pack using her own power, departed the five-sixteenths pole three wide, drifted inward a path or so in the initial portion of the stretch run, tired while not getting asked for her best. IRELAND three wide at the top of the lane, was never in contention. STORMIN MARY put to a prolonged drive, gave way.
