BRAZEN PERSUASION away without mishap at the start, broke on top, settled along on the inside before reaching the end of the backstretch, entered the turn with another pair applying pressure parked out in paths two and three, kept each of them at bay under some light hand urging, arrived at the end of the bend with BAHNAH taking aim and got called upon, inched away from that opponent during the ensuing furlong, although with that foe still staying latched on, had the co-winner close in steadily thereafter, dug in gamely late to reach the wire on even terms for the win. BAHNAH departed the backstretch from the three path, pressed the issue as the widest of three from the crown of the turn to its bottom, spun into the lane and was asked for her best, lost a slight amount of ground making her way through the furlong grounds, forged on ahead with good courage and began to whittle away at the advantage, got there in time to finish in a tie for top honors. ELENA STRIKES took the inside route for a good portion down the backstretch, initially pulling on the bit, tipped into the two path coming to the half mile pole, kept pace with the ongoing pace contest, was cued and angled outward until four wide by the top of the lane, lacked the needed stretch response. YES LIZ vied for command from between foes on the turn before backing away. SILVER VALLEY raced along the outside, under a firm hold by the pilot in the early going, failed to reach a contending position. TRUE BLUE NATION bobbed at the start, was under a drive turning for home three wide, made no impact. JONESIN FOR JERRY used from the gate, was kept to solid encouragement throughout the opening half, never made it into a forward position, rode the rail until upper stretch and gave way.
