TO DUBAI assumed a forward position soon after the start, departed the backstretch from the three path and underwent the pursuit from there until a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, responded positively when given his cue and kicked away from the competition during the run through the furlong

grounds, held on safely while kept to the task at hand. SPRING WARRIOR settled into the middle of the field, moved along the backstretch with the rider sitting aboard with a firm grip on the reins, was let out a notch upon reaching the turn, continued to bide time within striking distance coming to the quarter pole, got called upon after turning for home, gained ground gradually during the initial portion of the stretch drive, angled outward in mid lane, picked up real estate more readily thereafter, finished well but had to settle for the place. WAY OF THE WEST was taken in hand after being bumped between rivals shortly after the start, tucked along the inside the rode the rail until the quarter pole, undertook a maneuver entering the stretch that placed him four wide by the three-sixteenths pole, commenced to rally in earnest afterwards and came home with good energy to secure the show. MOMENTUM INVESTOR urged three wide into the stretch, made a move from upper to midstretch to reach the eighth pole closest to the top one only to flatten out. ROHERYN raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, displayed a mild stretch response en route to minor spoils. TOUGH ALL DAY was grabbed hold after ducking outward at the start, raced from off the inside, left the five-sixteenths pole three wide and asked for run, failed to respond appreciably. PYRO CITY pressed the issue from the two path until the three-eighths pole before backing away. RUNNING MADE EASY fanned six wide to the three-sixteenths pole, made little headway on the front runners. DESTINY'S SONG off the rail, failed to reach a contending position. TOP POSITION got bumped a short distance out of the starting, went on to gain the top and quickly tucked along the inside, argued for command from there, remained a prominent factor until midstretch then gave way. QUIET VALUE bumped after the start, tracked the front runners from the pocket while fighting against the bit in the opening stages, faltered.
