LIGNITE was very fast from the gate, quickly sprinted clear, controlled the action while off the rail, responded well when set down in earnest in upper stretch and held gamely under strong urging. KIMONO chased the winner on the outside then three wide on the turn, pursued that rival through a long drive and finished willingly for the place. SUSTAINED was away awkwardly then dropped back, raced at the rear while pushed along, went two to three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in during the drive and was best of the rest. TOASTING broke a bit slow then dropped back, was ridden along towards the rear, raced near the inside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WINE GLOW chased the pace on the inside of KIMONO, raced inside on the turn and tired. LIBERTY GIRL was ridden along while off the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn, had her path taken while out of contention near the furlong marker, moved to the outside and was no factor. OSCAR PARTY broke in at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, came inward in upper stretch and failed to respond.
