Footnotes

PRESUMPTIVE patiently rode the rail for nearly three-quarters, went on with it for a couple of jumps before following BECKRAM BEND to the outside during the later stages of the run around the far turn, entered the stretch and responded positively when given his cue, altered course gradually outward from the

three-sixteenths pole to the furlong marker, got put to a hard drive and closed in more readily on the front runners after finishing the maneuver, collared VERSAILLES ROAD with about a sixteenth to go, edged away to clear advantage, then had to dig in with good determination to fend off the late closing BEST ACTOR to preserve the decision. BEST ACTOR vacated the inside soon after departing the backstretch, began to pick up interest late on the second turn, was taken outward after coming into upper stretch, brushed lightly with SLAMBINO in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole taking away some position, commenced to rally in earnest, now six wide at that juncture, closed in fast during the final sixteenth but fell short. VERSAILLES ROAD contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, crept up to increase the pressure approaching the quarter pole, turned for home abreast of the leader and was soon called upon, fought his way to the front during the ensuing furlong, showed some determination before yielding in the late stages. UNACCOUNTABLE unhurried in midpack from off the inside, was already under encouragement taking the five path into the stretch, rallied well to secure the final check. BECKHAM BEND saved ground in the opening stages, was eased into the two path at the midway point on the second turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. TAPANNA three wide at the three-eighths pole, closed the gap to reach the front runners as the field headed into the stretch, remained in the thick of things for another furlong before flattening out. SLAMBINO put three wide at the seven-sixteenths pole, could only muster up a mild stretch response. RED LEADER stumbled at the start, raced along the outside, got asked for some run shortly after entering the far turn, failed to gain ground appreciably during the stretch run. POWHATAN COUNTY saved ground, needed some encouragement to keep pace by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. GOSPEL LESSON showed the way from the inside, came under heavy pressure after going six furlongs and asked for some run soon afterwards, held on well until mid lane before backing away. DAY OF DESTINY underwent a three to four wide journey, made a brief run starting from three-eighths pole, failed to sustain it and folded. TYCOON CAT rank as the trailer, was always outrun.
