PACIFIC OCEAN out broke the field, was conceded the front once CROSSBOW was taken back early down the backstretch, proved ratable on an open lead proceeding down the backstretch, horse's head cocked to the left, continued on the lead from the two path until the five-sixteenths pole before inching his way towards the rail during the ensuing sixteenth, got called upon spinning into the lane, slowly but steadily kicked clear of the others for good, crossing the wire under a strong hand ride. GOLDDIGGER'S BOY chased the winner three to four wide on the turn, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to garner place honors. CROSSBOW was put to a snug hold shortly after leaving the starting gate, was taken back, resulting in the top one being on a loose lead for nearly a half, attempted to increase the pressure coming to the three-eighths pole, failed in the task and was eventually outkicked for second. JACKSON BEND at or near the overland route during the run around the bend, lacked the necessary stretch response. CAIXA ELETRONICA saved ground to no avail. SCOTUS swung five wide into upper stretch, had no rally.
