FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken their maiden in a race at the Aqueduct spring or Belmont spring/summer meetings is eligible for a \$100,000 bonus which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a Graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2012. 121 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming 2lbs.; Maidens 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 7, 2012 with 26 Nominations.

SO MANY WAYS was ridden along on the outside, moved closer while three to four wide on the turn, chased in upper stretch, made a bid entering the final furlong and edged clear under right hand urging. CAN'T EXPLAIN was urged along while just off the pace, advanced two to three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the place. BABY J was restless in the gate, moved up to take the lead, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead near the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. FULLY LIVING was ridden along towards the back, raced four to five wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick. SWEET SHIRLEY MAE was restless in the gate, raced on the inside while urged along, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. BROWN EYES BLUE chased the pace, dropped back on the turn and stopped.
