Footnotes

ASSET INFLATION secured the pocket before reaching the end of the backstretch, contently tracked the front runners, was kept on hold momentarily awaiting suitable options as the field headed for the quarter pole, found room and angled outward at the head of the stretch, followed the errant pair of front runners up ahead towards the middle of the strip at two separate instances, initially during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds and then afterwards nearing the sixteenth pole, vied with them in the late stages and gamely proved best. POPPY'S WATCHING moved up to engage in a duel with GENTLE JIM very shortly after the break, disputed the pace primarily from the two path, not getting asked for his best, spun into the stretch and got set down, drifted outward steadily while still locked up in battle with the third place finisher, was eventually reeled in by the top one well past the sixteenth pole, but continued on with determination to win the fight for second. GENTLE JIM argued for command from the inside with the runner up, entered the stretch and proceeded to drift outward, battled hard to the end but had to settle for the show award. DOWNGOESFRAZIER tucked along the inside in the early going, slipped into the two path leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was unintentionally provided a clear avenue to the wire by the wayward front runners, lacked the needed response. ACIGARISJUSTACIGAR tipped into the three path approaching the three-eighths pole, was already under encouragement spinning into the lane, flattened out. INSIGHTING mostly three wide on the turn, gave way. SLIMSHADY fanned into the five path coming to the three-sixteenths pole, made no headway. CHANG'S SECRET rode the rail on the turn and launched no serious moves. SOLENKO four wide midway on the

turn, had no rally. KITSTRICKORTREAT away awkwardly, saved ground until the quarter pole. PETE AND DAVID in tight, checked in close proximity to another's heels in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, continued to race along the outside and tired. SAGUARO BLOSSOM four wide entering the turn, was in the five path exiting it, failed to reach a contending position.
