Footnotes

THERAPY hand urged leaving the starting gate in an attempt to secure forward position, was part of a tightly-packed grouping in the early going, tipped outward to maneuver into clearer sailing, was involved in a three way jostling incident involving IVANA PUCKER and ECHLUATH that lasted from about halfway down the backstretch to the top of the bend before finally bulling his way into clear possession of the two path, prompted the leader, doing so under light urging, arrived at the bottom of the turn and was called upon, got hooked up a spirited tussle with the runner up, forged to the front in the final seventy yards and edged away. COURAGEOUS KAREN broke well and grabbed the advantage, was guided over to the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, cut the pace with the winner making her presence parked to the outside, had that one crank up the pressure as the pair prepared to spin into the lane and was soon asked for run, battled hard and on nearly even terms with the top one to well past the sixteenth marker, got shaken off but continued onward in a willing manner for second. PIE'S FIRST LADY underwent a three wide pursuit and proved no match. AMBER MORNING was steadied after becoming rank between rivals leaving the backstretch, raced from off the inside, was under a drive entering the stretch six wide, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. SARAH'S WILD GIRL broke open the gate prior to the first try to send the field off and running, proceeded to come away without any apparent mishap, tucked along the inside, angled outward in upper stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. IVANA PUCKER was the third and outermost member on the receiving end of a series of bumps that started nearing the end of the backstretch and didn't finish until past the half mile pole, raced from off the inside for most of the way on the turn, was sent over to the rail leaving the five-sixteenths marker, cut the corner into the lane, came

up empty. ECHLUATH was jostled between rivals heading for the half mile pole, tucked into the two path and drafted behind the winner once all the bumping had ceased, this occurring at the top of the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, tired. HOT RENDEZVOUS fanned seven wide, the widest of all, into the stretch, had no offering. BILEAPS AND BOUNDS pulled on the bit in the early going riding the rail, while appearing uncomfortable, kept pace of the front runners in the pocket on the turn, was given her cue and angled sharply three wide into the stretch, gave way.
