Footnotes

AUTHENTICITY tracked the pace comfortably while on the outside, increased the pressure on the far turn, gained the lead after turning into the stretch, led into the final furlong, dropped in closer to her nearest pursuer at the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. FLASHY AMERICAN was rated while inside on the first turn, came off the rail on the backstretch, went two to three wide on the far turn, dropped to the rail in upper stretch then was put to a drive, chased the winner in the final furlong and finished with good courage but was second best. SEA ISLAND strolled to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the pace through slow fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, lost the lead to the winner, fought on into the final furlong then weakened while clear for the show. MOON PHILLY broke in and bumped with EBLOUISSANTE, was taken in hand early, went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, pursued the vanguard under the whip and tired. ROYAL LAHAINA raced off the rail early on the first turn, dropped closer to the inside late on that bend, was unhurried at the back, moved up nearing the half-mile pole, dropped back while ridden along against the rail on the far turn and retreated. EBLOUISSANTE was unruly in the gate then backed out and deemed fit to run, bumped with MOON PHILLY at the start and was last away, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, came under urging near the half-mile pole, dropped back while urged along on the far turn and faltered.
